 Career Clusters! Businesses host booths at either campus showing students the cool and rewarding work they do
 and how they can earn a career in those industries.
 - Reality Store
 - 8th graders from the greater Marshfield community learn valuable skills for their future! Students are assigned a "life" and have to determine how to manage a monthly budget with the help of our area businesses.
 - <u>Xtreme Xploration</u>
 - Juniors from surrounding schools take part in mock interviews, resume reviews, and learn about HR to get them thinking about what the working world is like and how to land their dream job!
 - <u>Crystal Apple Awards</u>
 - This is a great program that gives back to our educators! 4 individual teachers who go above and beyond for their school and community will be chosen to win \$1,000!




